### What is Child Protection about?

All of the adults around you think that your health, safety and welfare are very important. We want you to feel safe and secure. In our school, we respect all children, and help to protect your rights. We want you to feel safe from harmful words and actions.

We do our best to help children make good educational and emotional progress.

We want to teach you how to recognise risks in different situations, and how to protect yourselves and stay safe.

### How do we protect you at Kewaigue Primary School?

We provide a safe environment for you to learn.

We are a school where everyone has the right to feel SAFE; the right to LEARN without undue distraction or disruption and the right to RESPECT.

We want to help ensure that you remain safe at home as well as at school.

We think it is important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something.

### Need to talk?

You can talk to any adult in school if you need to, but Mr Shorthouse and Mrs Mylchreest will ALWAYS be there for you – just tell them what's worrying you.
